ABOUT THE COURSE

We are grateful to have José Kunzler presenting a kinetic approach to HVLA for the osteopathic profession.

José will talk about the use of high speed, short momentum use of kinetic energy into the targeted tissue. The tissue will respond with an osmotic relation towards its environment, instead of keeping isolated as a lesion. The reaction is often mediate, not immediate nor long term. The result and improvement are long term; there is no necessity for repeating treatment.

This involves pain free techniques that go with the tissue and not against, transmitting enough and no more of what is necessary for someone to create his own healing process.

The material to be covered on this program includes patient installation, meaning considerations of posture and other applications that will amplify the effectiveness of structural techniques. Operator positioning to better harmonise with your patients.

Discussion will be had about the philosophy of how, when and why one would use HVLA (high velocity low amplitude). José will then discuss techniques and principles of combined levers. This will be very useful for those who wish to learn how to refine their techniques further and improve their effectiveness and patient response.

The format of the presentation will be lecture sessions followed by practicals. There will be ample time for practicing techniques.

José will cover the cervical, thoracic and lumbar spine, ribs and the junctional areas.

PRESENTER PROFILE

José Kunzler

José initially trained as a physiotherapist in France, then trained as an osteopath in UK and France.

José has had many years of experience in lecturing to undergraduate and post graduate students particularly on technique and treatment methodology.

The lectures are based on three decades of experience in private practice and techniques, allowing satisfying long term results for patients. The techniques represent the dynamic evolution towards junction in terms of movement more than repositioning a structure on the midline.
